## How it works:

- 1) Participating Restaurants will prepare 5 gallons of homemade chili in their own restaurant. On site preparation is not allowed. Each participant will bring their chili to Centennial Park to be served at 11:30am.
- 2) Participating Restaurants must follow Health Code Regulations and have a valid Health Permit. Each restaurant **must provide their own server, serving utensils, and heating and other necessary equipment.** Electricity will be provided.
- 3) There will be no charge for the public to taste each chili. The DDA will provide bowls, spoons, and napkins.
- 4) Participating Restaurants can provide coupons or promotional materials. Participating Restaurants may offer a discount or specials inside their restaurants.
- 5) The public and a chosen panel will rate each chili based on flavor, texture, consistency, blend of spices, and aroma and color. Winners will be selected based in two categories: People's Choice (1st Place), and Judges Choice (2nd Place).
- 6) Winners will be announced on October 6<sup>th</sup> at 3:30pm in Centennial Park.
