DOWNTOWN OXFORD RECOGNIZED FOR ACHIEVEMENTS

OXFORD, MICHIGAN - The Oxford Downtown Development Authority | Main Street attended Main Street Oakland County's (MSOC) annual Main Event awards night on Thursday, April 28th at the Royal Oak Music Theater. Each year, MSOC hosts an awards night to recognize the achievements of Oakland County's Main Street Communities.

Oxford received awards in two categories. Outstanding Main Street Business and Outstanding Organizational Transition.

Outstanding Main Street Business award went to Sullivan's Public House. Owners Jerry and Jamie Cremin were present to accept the award. This award recognizes the outstanding dedication and commitment to the community and downtown Oxford. Sullivan's is a consistent participant in downtown events, Jerry serves on Main Street Committees, the DDA Board, and actively participates in various aspects of the community.

The Oxford DDA received award for Outstanding Organization Transition. Last June, following the resignation of then executive director, the organization hit the ground running with the recruitment, and hiring of a new director. The new Executive Director, Joe Frost, has since led the organization to National Main Street Accreditation, and is continuing to develop, promote, and preserve downtown Oxford.

Main Street Oakland County honored several other community. MSOC created the awards program in 2004. It recognizes excellence in downtown revitalization in such areas as design, economic restructuring, organization and promotion.
